Build more homes, faster, to meet demand	<ul> <li>Our design and construction teams are now reliably delivering 8-10 houses per year.</li> <li>With a wait-pool of 60 local families, growing by 10-15 per year, the need to keep moving as fast as we can is clear.</li> </ul>
Acquire land for future housing needs	<ul> <li>We have succesfully acquired land to keep us in full production through 2027 (Evergreen Loop and then Cascade Meadows North).</li> <li>We are excited to be currently planning for the future with the Methow Conservancy on Sunny M.</li> </ul>
Broaden our reach	<ul> <li>We have expanded eligibility requirements to include the growing group of community members who have been priced out of market homeownership.</li> <li>We remain focused on outreach efforts, working to ensure all those who are eligible are aware and well supported.</li> </ul>

In 2023 we plan to complete site development (roads<u>, u</u>tilities, site grading) on 8 acres in Winthrop: MHT plans to build 24 single family homes, and the Housing Authority of Okanogan plans to create 22 rentals.

## 2022 Financial Summary

2022 was a big year for the Methow Housing Trust. We are now consistently building neighborhoods of 8-10 homes per year, while concurrently developing infrastructure for the next neighborhood.

Our campaign to "Build Belonging," completed in 2022, raised enough capital for MHT to reach 50 homes, but our work will most certainly not end there.

MHT's 60 person wait pool continues to grow by 10-15 households per year. This means that we've got work to do for years to come!
